



B.1 IT IS UNLAWFUL TO INSTALL THIS UNIT WITHOUT FIRST OBTAININGA PERMIT FROM THE LOCAL ELECTRICAL INSPECTION AUTHORITY.


- Do not dry clothes or leave towels in the sauna.

- Do not use the sauna if you have any of the following conditions;
- 1. Have unhealed wounds, eye problems or severe burns;
- 2.the elderly, the infirm, and especially the sick. Pregnant women and infants are prohibited;
- 3. Patients suffering from hyperthermia, obesity, heart disease, high blood pressure, circulatory diseases or diabetes must consult a doctor before using this product.
- Do not put pets in the sauna.
- Do not use after excessive alcohol consumption.
- Do not install sauna near water, bathtubs, showers, wet basements or swimming pools.
- Do not use liquid cleaners or aerosol cleaners in the sauna. Before cleaning, it is necessary to disconnect the power and unplug the outlet. Scrubbing with water and a soft cloth is recommended.
- If it is necessary to use a wall outlet adapter or extension cord between the sauna power cord and the wall outlet, use a product that complies with the standard regulations.







C.2 Attention before instalation

- Do not share the same plug with other appliances.
- Posi tion it on a flat level surface.
- Do not splash the exterior with water.lf the floor is damp, install a floor separator to keep the sauna dry & high.
- Do not store the flammable objects or chemical substances near the sauna.








Operating instructions:

After the power is turned on, press "ion", the green light is on, and the negative ion working mode is entered. Press the O3 key, the red light is on, and the ozone working mode is entered. in the ozone mode, after about 15minutes, it is automatically converted to the negative ion mode.

C.3 Product Installation Steps



- Press the lon Button: It can significantly purify the air and remove toxic substances, including dust and mold odors.
- .Press the Ozone Button: Ozone can kill viruses and is ultimately converted back to oxygen without causing secondary pollution, which is something chemical agents cannot achieve. (When disinfecting, it is essential for individuals to leave the sauna room.)

C.4 Procedure for replacing the heater (reference step only)

WARNING: Only qualified personnel should replace the heater, make sure power is disconnected before servicing.

C.4.1 Example of a heating plate above a side seat

1. Use a screwdriver to remove the wooden fence of the heater to bereplaced





2. Carefully remove the heater, find the connector between the heater and the sauna wall, disconnect the connector between the heater and the sauna wall, and use a screwdriver to remove the screws that hold the heater to the wooden fence.







- 3. ①Replace the heater with a new one and fix it to the wooden fence with screws.
 - 2 Connect the heater to the power cord on the sauna room.
 - 3 Fix the replaced heater to the wall of the sauna room with screws.

C.4.2 Example of heating tubes on seat risers

1. Use a screwdriver to remove the heater grille to be replaced.



2. Use sharp-nosed pliers and other tools to remove the wire that secures the ends of the heating tube.





3. Locate the two connections of the heating tubes on the back of the seat riser and detach them to remove the heating tubes.





- 4. 1 Replace the heating tube with a new one.
 - (2) Fix the heating tube on the reflector.
 - **3** Connect the power cord of the heater at the back of the plate.
 - (4) Fix the heater grille with screws

D.OPERATION

Note: Before opening the sauna, please remove the plastic protective film from the control panel and check and confirm the power connection.

The power supply, heater and temperature sensor are properly connected, and the power supply voltage and frequency must match the required voltage and frequency of the sauna (120V/15A dedicated circuit)

D.1 Use of the sauna room pull the temperature

sensor vertically down, as shown below, to ensure the accuracy of the temperature display on the control panel.





Control Panel Usage:

- Press the switch button [7], the power indicator [5] lights up and the temperature display [1]shows the temperature in the room.Press the switch button [7] again, the power indicator [5] goes out.
- Press time + [10] or time [11] to adjust the sauna use time, if the time display [2] for 00, the sauna will stop heating.
- Press [12] and [13] at the same time, Fahrenheit temperature and Celsius temperature can be converted to each other.

- Sauna temperature can be adjusted: 30 ~ 65 °C (86-149 °F), when the inside of the sauna room reaches the set temperature, the sauna room will automatically turn off the heating function, detecting one degree lower will automatically turn on the heating function; set the self-temperature memory;
- Sauna time can be adjusted: 1~90 minutes, when the countdown is zero, it will send out 5 reminders and the sauna room will be shut down automatically: heating plate, "heating" lamp, temperature display, time display; the setting comes with time memory;
- Color lighting control: press [8], once on again off, long press to the display [1] appears "LX 2n", and then press the [8] key can change the color of the color lights. L1,L2, L3, L4, L5, L6, L7, onbehalf of the different colors, L8 for the slow change of color, L9 for the rapid change of color.
- Beauty light control: press [9], once on and again off
 - Colored lights and beauty lights are not limited by thecountdown timer of the sauna heating mode.
- Multimedia Mode Adjustment; press [12] to turn music on/off.Press [15] can switch the selection mode: FM-AUX-BLUE-SD-USB. Press [19] to debug the previous song, press [20] to debug the next song, press [21] to play/stop the song, press [22]/[23] to adjust the sound size.
- Bluetooth connection status [BLUE]: Device name G 811
 - Music playback will stop automatically when incoming call During an incoming call, short press [21] play button to answer the call, long press [21] play button to reject the call.
 - During a call, short press [21] play button to hang up, long press [21] play button to transfer to cell phone to answer the call.
- For the first use of the radio, please long press the [21] play button the player will automatically search for stations and memorize them.
 - D.4 If needed, open ceiling vents to allow fresh air flow



E.TIPS FOR USE

- Place the equipment in a suitable position before use.
- Before using the equipment, please check whether the power supplymeets the requirements;
- turn all the switches on, adjust the time and temperature, and preheat for 10-15 minutes;
- After preheating, you can adjust the required time and temperature again according to your personal situation, the temperature is usually 40-45°C and the time is 30-40 minutes;

- turn all the switches on, adjust the time and temperature, and preheat for 10-15 minutes;
- When using the equipment, please drink plenty of warm boiled water to replenish the water lost due to perspiration;
- When using the equipment, any part of the body should avoid contacting the inner wall of the
 equipment with the heater for a long period of time, so as not to cause low-temperature burns;
- When using the appliance, please keep the appliance in full contact with the ground, and not put it
 on the quilt or shag carpet, if you find that the contact surface is overheated, please stop using it
 immediately;
- Please do not put towels and other items inside the equipment being used for a long time, if you need to pad the towel should always pay attention to the state of the towel;
- In winter or when the weather is cold and the room temperature is low(below 10°C), you may not feel hot enough during the use of the appliance;
- It is recommended to use the sauna twice a day per person, preferably between 9:00 am and 9:00 pm;
- It is not recommended to use the sauna immediately after a meal; it isadvisable to use it 1 hour after the meal;
- If you need to take a shower, it is advisable to take a shower before using the equipment, and dry the sweat drops when using the equipment;
- After use, please turn off the power switch and unplug it.

F.FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Always turn off the power before servicing the sauna. If the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified person to avoid danger.
